THE SCHOOL

Siddhartha International School is an English medium co-educational senior secondary (10+2) residential public school affiliated to the C.B.S.E., New Delhi under the management of Siddhartha Educational & Charitable Trust (Regd.), Samalkha, Haryana. The school follows the basic principle and ideals of Buddhist philosophy to make the students a better human being and an ideal citizen of India.

The school is named SIDDHARTHA INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL after the name of SIDDHARTHA the childhood name of Gautam Buddha. The Buddha sacrificed all the material comforts available to him in search of true knowledge to get himself enlightened and in turn enlightened the man-kind. His teachings are ever relevant especially in the backdrop of present day world scenario, which demands restraint, ahimsa (non-violence) and kindness towards humanity. Guided by Buddha's philosophy and ideals for the humanity, some philanthropists and educationists founded the Siddhartha Educational & Charitable Trust in the year 1991. The trust cares for the orphans, semi-orphans and destitute children. The trust aims at promoting the values of love and kindness so forcefully taught by the Lord Buddha, through Educational and Charitable activities. ACADEMIC SESSION & ADMISSION PROCEDURE

For Boarders and Day Boarders

The School year is from 1st April to 31st March. The school closes for summer vacation from 16th May to 1st July.

1. Registration form is to be submitted duly filled in and within the due date with registration fee of Rs. 500.00 is to be remitted by cash or by bank draft in the name of the Siddhartha International School, Samalkha (Haryana).
2. Students have to appear at the pre-admission test on the date intimated.
3. The candidates getting through the test will be enlisted for admission on the basis of the marks obtained by them. Admissions will be allowed according to the seats vacant in each class. Rest of the candidates will remain in waiting.
4. Admission will be finalized only when the fees as per schedule is deposited.
5. Once a student gets admission in the school his/her seat is booked for the whole term. Therefore the fees deposited once in no case are refunded.
6. Birth Certificate must be enclosed for admission.

CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENT

A challenging and relevant curriculum is offered and student's performance demonstrates their satisfaction and development. The academic session is from April to March. The First term is from April to August, the Second Term from September to December and the Third Term from January to March. Besides half yearly and annual examination, unit tests and weekly tests are also conducted to provide better feed-back and to build up the student's strength, overcome weakness and to progress to the next step in the learning process. Continuous and comprehensive evaluation system is being followed in the primary classes. The school is sensitive to the needs of the individual, and provision is made for special needs, including remedial educational programme, supervised home work assignment, programme for gifted and talented children.

STAFF

The school has an experienced principal and highly qualified and competent staff, for specialized teaching in various subjects. Our teaching staff is given Central Govt. scale. The staff-student ratio remains 1:25.

CO-CURRICULUR ACTIVITIES

Inter House competitions are held in various disciplines like debate, recitations, quiz, dance, painting, rangoli etc. To inculcate a spirit of unity and solidarity, celebrations of national festivals like Independence Day, Republic Day, major religious festivals and other important days too find a place in the school curriculum.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Games and athletics are given due importance to promote a healthy body, leadership and sportsmanship. The students play cricket, Basketball, Volleyball etc. Students are also encouraged to participate in district and state level meets. Many students have played for state (Haryana) in different games.

SCHOLARSHIP & AWARDS

To encourage deserving students with financial hardships, the school provides assistance to orphans, the children of widows, handicapped parents of downtrodden and marginalized section of the society. In addition, the school also awards scholarship to the students, who are academically bright.

CAREER COUNSELLING

The school has a Counseling Wing, which probes into student's problems other than academic ones. Since the school aims at the overall development of the individual, each student's progress is streamlined by eliminating psycho-social and emotional barriers which the students may come across in the process of their development. The Counseling Wing also extends guidance and counseling to the students in making a right choice for their career. Students are guided to opt for the most appropriate options after studying the available prospects and their individual talent and aptitude.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

* Includes academic charges as well. No other charges are to be borne by the student during the academic year.

Note:- Hostel charges should be paid within the stipulated time shown in the craft failing which a fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be charged upto 10 days of the prescribed time. After that the name of the child will be struck off from the roll of the school.

SATURDAY FORUM

Saturday afternoon is the time for cultural and literary activities like debates, oration, recitation mono-play, songs, music etc.

LEAVE AND ATTENDANCE

1. A pupil will be eligible to appear in the annual exam if he/she has completed 75% attendance.
2. Leave to a student for absence is granted only on an application addressed to the principal in time duly signed by the parents.
3. In case of illness, a medical certificate must be attached with the application.
4. The name of the child will be struck off from the rolls of the school if he/she is absent for more than a week without leave application

MEETING THE PRINCIPAL & TEACHERS

Parents may meet the Principal on working days from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon. For any other timing prior appointment may be sought as per convenience. Parents can meet teachers to discuss matters regarding their wards on Parent Teacher meet and on any other day with permission of the Principal only.

DISCIPLINE

The authorities keep a vigilant eye on the activities of the children. They are counseled, encouraged and guided for improvement in the formation of character, habit, moral, inner and outer self. Lapses of conduct and deficiencies are taken due notice and remedial measures are taken promptly and guided accordingly for the better citizen.

The school maintains a high standard of discipline and demand from the students the seriousness to their studies. We also expect full co-operation from the parents and they are required to honour the rules and regulations themselves as well as seeing their wards also do the same.

1. Student must come to school punctually and regularly dressed in the school uniform.
2. Their behavior among themselves or with the teachers must be proper.
3. Any misbehavior / conduct which spoil the atmosphere of the school will be dealt seriously and the school reserves its right to expel the students with or without warning.

WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal of a student from the school can be affected as follows:-

On the request of the parent one month notice should be given to school.
For unsocial conduct and behavior.
Non Payment of school fees on time

The school fees for the entire session will have to be paid before getting a withdrawal

PARENT'S PARTICIPATION

Suggestions from parents are always welcome and are given due consideration. It is expected of the guardians that their activities out of affection may not disturb the daily routine of the children. They have to behave so wisely when they meet the child that his sentiments may not be aroused and cause home sickness. The following participations are requested to be taken when the guardians happen to visit the institution:

Prior Appointment is necessary.
The warden is required to be informed if the permission is taken by the principal.
The entry in the Hostel is not allowed.
Anything given to the child must be brought to the notice of the warden.
They should leave the child in good spirits when they depart.
The child should not be visited for at least 60 days after admission. In the matters of Emergency, the guardians may be permitted to see their ward.
Usually the Guardians meeting hours are fixed and they may see their wards between 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. on the last Sunday of the month.
The out-stationed guardians are requested to get prior permission to avoid disappointment.

SCHOOL CLINIC & MEDICAL CARE

The students are provided necessary medical facilities. They are physically examined and the health records are maintained.

EVALUATION & GRADING

Continuous comprehensive evaluation is recorded and graded as per achievements of the student up to class V. Grading is recorded as given below:

A student must obtain at least D for promotion to higher class.

1. A cumulative average of 40% marks in each subject is required for promotion. Exams are held in November and March besides regular unit tests and weekly basis.
2. Absence on genuine medical ground will be treated as leave and in such case promotion will be considered on the basis of previous performance.
3. Absence on day with or without medical certificate for unit test / exam will not be considered for ranking.
4. Postponement, Preponement, retest will not be made in any oral or written test in any class.
5. Malpractice in any unit test / exam will be considered as having secured zero marks; malpractice will be seriously dealt with.
